



Re: Letter of Recommendation for Dr. David Kingston

Dr. David Kingston served as Sponsor's Medical Monitor for six phase 1 and phase 2 clinical trials sponsored by Collaborative Medicinal Development in Australia from 2016 through 2021. Dr. Kingston was the best Medical Monitor with whom I have had the privilege of working, considering

- Dr. Kingston carefully reviewed data – not just checked boxes on an enrollment eligibility form—to ensure that potential study subjects met enrollment criteria. He followed up with study nurses and investigators to gather missing data and provide justifications for waivers, as appropriate.
- When I questioned data on study listings, I could always rely on Dr. Kingston to follow-up with study nurses and investigators to resolve issues, often resulting in correcting eCRF entries and causality assessments for adverse events.
- Dr. Kingston was an active participant in Data Monitoring Committee meetings, as he was more familiar with study data than most investigators.
- Dr. Kingston conducted study audits for a few studies, meetings with nurses, physicians, and pharmacists, as appropriate, to ensure study records were accurate.
- During study closures, Dr. Kingston worked closely with study staff and the CRO's CRAs to ensure that cCRF entries accurately reflected primary records and achieve timely site closures.

I would not hesitate to ask Dr. Kingston to serve as Medical Monitor if I were to have the pleasure of conducting another clinical study in Australia.
